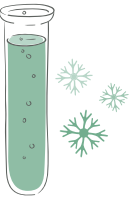

 Egg freezing approved for fertility preservation by FDA

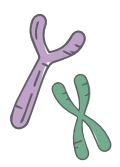
Counsyl screens performed on all egg donors

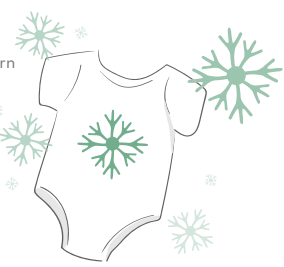

First egg donor cycles at ORM

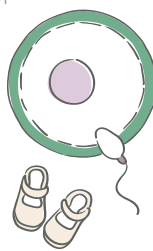

ORM opens office in Shanghai

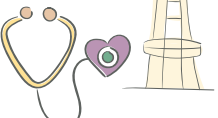
